 - Transfers received after the deadline for submission, or any incomplete transfers shall not be accepted. A producer may withdraw or amend a Name Change application, provided such withdrawal or amendment is in writing in the form of a letter, telegram, telex or facsimile message (fax) and received by the DFNB prior to the end of the first day of the month. Such withdrawal or amendment must be clear and unambiguous as to intent and must identify the Producer by name and producer number and must specify the Name Change that is to be withdrawn or amended.
