New requirements for dairy farm site relocation

On July 24, 2014, the Board of Directors held a conference call to deliberate on the policies regulation the relocation of a dairy farm from its current site to a new site. The board observed that the current policy did not provide any separation distances from existing dairy farms. Directors added the following conditions to ensure that a new dairy farms placement relative to an existing one doesn't restrict it from being sold as a stand alone unit in the future.

The new site relocation requirement that came into effect on July 24, 2014 is that **DFNB will only approve the relocation of a licensed farm to a new site when the producer has demonstrated that the new site to be licensed is situated at least 300 feet away from the property line of any neighboring licensed dairy farms and further demonstrate that the new site's access from a provincial road is independent from any neighboring dairy farm's driveway.**
